

# Berlin's most famous landmark celebrates its anniversary - 55 years of the Berlin TV Tower, Tim Raue conjures up a birthday menu

The Day of German Unity will be a very special holiday this year. On October 3, 2024, the Berlin TV Tower will celebrate its 55th anniversary with a top-class culinary event. With his birthday menu, Berlin's most famous Michelin-starred chef Tim Raue will provide a foretaste of the restaurant opening of the "Sphere by Tim Raue" in 2025 - part of the comprehensive renovation of Berlin's most famous landmark. The morning gets off to an extraordinary start with an authentic Berlin breakfast, created by the top chef with regional ingredients from farmer Torsten Rahlf. There will be celebrations throughout the day, and guests will have the only opportunity to enjoy an exclusive Tim Raue menu from the new "Sphere by Tim Raue" opening in 2025 as early as 2024.



"Preparations for our 55th anniversary are currently in full swing. We are very proud to be able to offer such a culinary highlight. Tim Raue will make our birthday an unforgettable day with his exclusive menu," says Anja Nitsch, Managing Director of the Berlin TV Tower.

Tickets for the special breakfast can be purchased online for the morning between 9:00 and 11:30. At the same time, Tim Raue presents an authentic Berlin breakfast, enriched with local specialties from regional farmer Torsten Rahlf - but also enriched many an international influence. Just is the case in the capital itself.

From 12:00 to 20:30, guests can then book the exclusive Tim Raue birthday menu to get a first culinary impression of the "Sphere by Tim Raue" - the official opening is planned for spring 2025. The price for the menu is 124 euros per person. A total of three courses will be presented - as an omnivorous and vegetarian option. Both menu options include corresponding beverage accompaniment. There will be an alcoholic beverage accompaniment consisting of selected wines from top German winegrowers, as well as a non-alcoholic beverage accompaniment.

With his birthday menu, the top Berlin chef embarks on a creative journey through time: "The October 3 is a very special day for me personally, as it represents the end of the division of my hometown. I have therefore combined the past, present and future in my menu. When I think of the past, my first culinary thought is always of salmon - the ultimate for me back then. The menu is offered with both fish and meat as well as vegetarian options - and thus represents the gastronomy of the present. And the view into the future is simply comforting and sweet with velvety cheesecake cream, salty butter crumbs and refreshing quince."

**Background television tower:**

At 368 meters, the Berlin TV Tower is the tallest building in Germany and the second tallest publicly accessible building in Europe. With over 1.2 million visitors a year, the TV tower on Alexanderplatz is one of Berlin's most popular attractions. A unique feature is the rotating restaurant

"Sphere", which rotates a full 360 degrees once or twice an hour at a height of 207 meters. The "Sphere Bar" below can also be reached via two high-speed elevators (6 meters per second). The TV tower is open 363 days a year from 09:00 to 23:00.

Thanks to augmented reality, the free Magnicity app helps you find your way around Berlin and learn more about the city's most important buildings, places and sights via info points and 3D filters.
